## What Parents Need to Know!!!

### Curriculum Night is September 14, at 7:00pm

This is your first formal opportunity to show your children that their education is important to you. Come meet our new staff members, your child's teacher, and find out what is new at Matthew!!

### Allergy Alert!!!!

As in past years we have children in our school with life-threatening allergies. Please remember that **Nuts, Nut Products, and Fish** are not permitted in our school. Be sure to check the labels of the products you buy for your child's snacks to ensure they are free of these items. A friendly reminder that some restaurants use peanut oil to cook their foods and these are not permitted in our school. Please check with the business you are purchasing from as most have switched to other nut free oils. We ask you to also make sure that the business has not stored the nut free product directly with other nut laden foods, as these could carry enough of the allergen to kill a child. It is also very important to remember this before sending class snacks during special events. Please make sure you check with your child's teacher before preparing class items. We say a very big **THANK YOU** in advance for helping us keep our school safe.

### Parking and Student Drop Off

We will be sending home our parking policy signature sheets soon. Please make sure they are returned to your child's teacher promptly and please make sure you follow our policy closely.

### Fundraising

As per previous years we try to limit fundraising. There will be two fundraising ventures before Christmas—Our vegetable sale will go ahead for Thanksgiving, and we are hoping to continue our partnership with Downhome and will be circulating more info on this fundraiser when it becomes available. ### Scent Restricted Zone

As is the case in many public buildings, Matthew Elementary works to be scent free. Please make sure not to wear scented cosmetics or products into the school.

### Grade Seven and Eight News!!!

Through discussions with students, staff, and parents we are highlighting some particular policies and guidelines to help shape our school day with adolescent students. Parents need to be aware that:

- grade seven and eight students can leave our building at 12:00 to go for the lunch period. If parents do not want their children to leave the school they should contact us;
- we will be closely monitoring attendance and lateness. Please make sure your child gets to school on time;
- Students and parents need to know that the school reserves the right to monitor the food being brought back to school during the lunch period. Sugary snacks, sport drinks, and caffeine laden drinks like red bull should never be brought to school. Please talk to your child about what he or she buys at lunch time and please make sure you help them make the right choices.
- Parents and students need to know that if we smell smoke on a child we will be contacting the home. It is illegal for students of this age to smoke, and if we find cigarettes on any student it will be treated as an illegal offense; and,
- parents need also to speak to their child about the need to get assignments handed in on time. We will be watching this very closely as the year progresses.

### School Foot Wear and Dress

As you know, students are **expected to change their outdoor footwear immediately after arrival at school**. Please be sure that **any footwear purchased for school has a non-marking sole**. If you inadvertently purchase shoes that leave marks on the floor they will not be able to be worn in school. We remind you as well that **sneakers with wheels** are not allowed at school. They are the “in thing”, but they are extremely dangerous in and around school, and, they leave terrible black marks on our floors.

And please do not forget our school dress code which prohibits the showing of bellies and backs, clothing with offensive symbols or writing, and very short skirts.
